
The Use of Conjunctions in the Kompas Newspaper

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Abstract

The purpose of writing this article is to describe the use of conjunctions in the Kompas Newspaper. The data collected is the conjunction in the July 2021 edition of the Opinion section of the Kompas Newspaper. Based on the data collected, the Opinion in the July 2021 Edition of the Kompas Newspaper totals 12 titles. Data collection was carried out using note-taking techniques. Data analysis is done by classifying and identifying. From the data that has been processed, it is concluded that there are two conjunctions found in the Opinion of the July 2021 Edition of the Kompas Newspaper, namely coordinative and subordinating conjunctions. The tendency of the conjunction used is the subordinating conjunction.

Introduction

Communication activity has one of the most important aspects, namely language. In communication activities, language is a must for these activities to be achieved. Humans communicate with various media used. One of the media used in communicating is with print mass media such as newspapers or newspapers. In newly published newspapers and local newspapers, conjunctions or conjunctions have become daily food for newspaper writers. Not only in newspapers, wherever we do language activities, there are always conjunctions in it either consciously or unconsciously we do or say. This conjunction has many types in its grouping, one of which is coordinating and subordinating conjunctions. These two conjunctions are conjunctions that are commonly used in daily speech and activities. We always encounter this conjunction every time we say words or in conversations with other people as well as in newspapers, especially local newspapers.

In writing this article, the author formulates the problem: 1) How to write coordinating conjunctions in the opinion section of the Kompas newspaper, the July 2021 edition? 2) How to write subordinating conjunctions in the opinion section of the Kompas newspaper, the July 2021 edition?

To support the writing of this article, it is necessary to put forward theories related to the problem and the scope of the discussion as the basis for making this article.

Methods

This study uses a qualitative approach with the type of text study research. This qualitative approach is used to explore and explain the results of the analysis regarding the object under study, namely coordinative and subordinative conjunctions in the opinion section of the Kompas newspaper, the July 2021 edition. This qualitative approach describes the phenomenon textually. This qualitative approach describes the phenomenon textually. The research method used in this research is descriptive research method.

Data collection was carried out using note-taking techniques. Data analysis was carried out by grouping and identifying coordinating and subordinating conjunctions in the opinion section of the Kompas newspaper, the July 2021 edition.

Checking the validity of the data was carried out in writing this article in two ways, namely (1) persistence in observing data, and (2) checking colleagues through discussion activities. With persistence in observation, researchers observed in depth and examined all data sources, both theoretically and practically, regarding the use of coordinating and subordinating conjunctions in the opinion section of the Kompas newspaper, the July 2021 edition.

Results and Discussion

Based on the results of an analysis of the use of Indonesian conjunctions found in the July 2021 edition of the Kompas newspaper, which consists of coordinating conjunctions and subordinating conjunctions. The use of these conjunctions will be analyzed based on the data obtained in the July 2021 edition of the Kompas newspaper. Coordinating Conjunctions

The coordinating conjunctions found in the July 2021 edition of the Kompas newspaper are *dan*, *namun*, *atau*, *dari*, *tetapi*, *bahkan*, *serta*, and *padahal*. The data are as follows.

The subordinating conjunctions found in the July 2021 edition of the Kompas newspaper are *setelah*, *jika*, *apabila*, *karena*, *sampai*, *ketika*, *bahwa*, *daripada*, *yang*, and *waktu*. The data are as follows.

Conclusion

Based on the description above, it can be concluded that a newspaper consists of several sections of opinion which, of course, in one opinion there are also conjunctions or connecting words that complete the opinion. The conjunctions studied in writing this article are coordinating and subordinating conjunctions. From these two conjunctions, there are several conjunctions that are often used in opinions found in the Kompas newspaper. The tendency of the conjunction that is often used is the subordinating

conjunction, because in the opinions studied, coordinating conjunctions appear more often than coordinating conjunctions.

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
